Naming Opportunities



Pantry Van | \$25,000

Pantry Aisle | \$5,000

Produce Prep Area | \$25,000

Support the heart of fresh food distribution by naming the Produce Preparation Area! Used daily by volunteers, this space is where fresh produce is unloaded, cleaned, and prepared for neighbors in need. Your gift ensures a safe, efficient, and welcoming area to handle nutritious fruits and vegetables. Your name or organization will be here in perpetuity.



Raised Garden Bed | \$500

Support fresh, local food access by naming a raised garden bed in our OhioHealth Community Garden! These beds grow nutritious fruits and vegetables for neighbors in need, augmenting our fresh produce needs by nearly 20%.

Annual donations at the \$5,000 level and higher will be recognized at the Pantry on the rotating digital donor celebration wall.

Capital Improvements & Maintenance

HVAC Replacement | \$11,500

A reliable heating and cooling system ensures that fresh food stays properly stored and that everyone who enters our space is welcomed with comfort and dignity—no matter the season.

Sink Disposal | \$3,400

A fully functioning kitchen sink is essential for sanitation and efficiency at the Pantry. A new commercial disposal, plus updated electrical work, will keep our kitchen running smoothly as we prepare and clean up after food distributions.

Vehicle Costs | \$10,000

Our vehicles bring produce and shelf-stable items to the Pantry to serve those in need. Covering fuel, insurance, and maintenance keeps our trucks on the road and our mission moving forward.

Laptops | \$1,000 each

2 Needed

Microsoft Surface Pro laptops are used daily by staff and volunteers to check in shoppers, manage food inventory, and coordinate essential services.

Curb Repairs | \$5,700

Repairing the curbs and sidewalks around our building keeps families and volunteers safe and helps prevent more costly repairs down the road.

Cold Storage Maint. | \$1,500

Annual maintenance for our cold storage system prevents costly breakdowns and food waste, ensuring we can store fresh, nutritious food safely all year round.

Snow Removal | \$4,100

Safe access to the Pantry is crucial, especially in the winter months. Your gift helps us keep driveways and walkways clear, so our neighbors in need and volunteers can reach the Pantry safely.

Baby Changing Station | \$600

Every parent deserves a safe, clean space to care for their little ones. By installing changing stations in both restrooms, we make the Pantry more accessible and family-friendly.

Programmatic & Operating Support

Support One Month of Pantry Operating Costs | \$33,400

Power an entire month of critical pantry operations—fueling food deliveries, stocking shelves, maintaining refrigeration, and ensuring neighbors receive the nourishment they need. With a lean but mighty team and an incredible volunteer base, your gift directly supports our ability to feed neighbors in need.

Support Our Food is Medicine Program | \$2,500

Hunger shouldn't be a barrier to health, learning, or athletic performance. Through OhioHealth's Athletic Training program in Dublin City Schools, the Pantry provides healthy snacks for food-insecure student-athletes at Davis Middle School, Sells Middle School, and Scioto High School.

Support One Week of Pantry Operating Costs | \$7,700

A week of giving means thousands of meals, stocked shelves, and a fully operational pantry for neighbors in need. Your support covers essential costs like food sourcing, refrigeration, and transportation, ensuring that every family who turns to us leaves with healthy food and hope.

Support One Day of Pantry Operating Costs | \$1,100

Each day, the Dublin Food Pantry provides fresh, nutritious food to families facing hunger. Your gift keeps the doors open, the lights on, and the shelves full, making a direct impact where it matters most—feeding neighbors in need.
